This Curriculum analysis includes various questions for stakeholders to respond to, with options such as "strongly agree, not sure, disagree and strongly disagree". Furthermore, investigation of the yield is analyzed by examining their perspective.

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

The detailed analysis of feedback is carried out and a detailed feedback report is prepared.


#### Stage III (Plan of Action)
